

LIBIN CARDIOVASCULAR INSTITUTE (LCI) PUBLICATION AWARDS DEADLINE: Tuesday, January 31st, 2023

The Libin Cardiovascular Institute (LCI) offers awards to recognize trainees' publication successes.

The LCI Publication Awards are designed to recognize and reward trainees at all levels for quality cardiovascular research. All trainee first-authored papers published in peer-reviewed journals are eligible for the award.

AWARD: \$100

TERMS OF REFERENCE

- Trainee must have, as first author, an original research article published in a recognized, peer-reviewed
 journal in the <u>2022</u> calendar year. Papers published before or after 2022 are not eligible. Reviews are not
 eligible.
- Articles that meet <u>SAGER Guidelines</u> are now eligible for LCI Sex & Gender Publication Awards, funded by the LCI's Women's Cardiovascular Health Initiative. The SAGER Guidelines are a guide for reporting sex and gender information in study design, data analysis, results and interpretations of findings.
- Paper must have the Libin Cardiovascular Institute listed as an affiliation.
- Trainee must be a full-time postdoctoral scholar, graduate (MSc and PhD) or undergraduate student in good standing at the time of publication.
- ALL trainees must have a supervisor who is a full member of the Libin Cardiovascular Institute.
- This award can only be received once per trainee per annual competition.
- If there are more applications than available awards, applications will be ranked and awarded according to the impact of the research.
- Trainees may submit more than one publication; however, each publication will only be considered for one LCI Publication Award or one LCI Sex & Gender Publication Award. One publication will not qualify for both awards at the same time.

Applications will be evaluated for eligibility by the Libin Cardiovascular Institute's Education Director, and if necessary, ranked to determine recipients. In addition to a \$100 award, successful applicants will have their publications recognized in the Libin Buzz.
