## External Speaker Series

Develop your presentation and research critiquing skills alongside your peers at this student-moderated monthly session. Each session will include a 30-minute presentation—on a recent paper relevant to the presenter’s research—from both a basic research trainee and clinical research trainee with a 30-minute group discussion to follow. Cardiovascular Journal Club is held on the first and third Thursday of each month, with lunch provided. *Trainees are expected to present at least once during the year; supervisors are expected to attend when their trainee presents.*

Present your work at national and international conferences and symposia and be eligible to receive Travel Awards of up to \$1,500 per year.

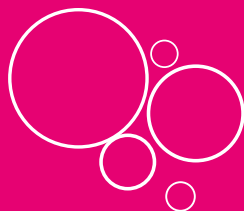
Receive an Excellence in Research Prize when you become a first author in a publication for the first time.
